Overview of the Proposed Changes to the Ecology Building Society Memorandum

A special resolution has been proposed in Item 5 in the Notice of Meeting to update the Memorandum of the Society. This note explains the alterations. A special resolution is a resolution that is put forward for consideration by members and will be passed if at least 75% of the members who vote, vote in favour of the resolution.

Every building society is required to have a Memorandum which sets out the activities that the building society can undertake.

The Society's memorandum contains a prohibition on it giving a floating charge. This was in line with the statutory provisions of the Building Societies Act 1986. This statutory provision was removed by Parliament in March 2015 so it can also be removed from the Society's Memorandum.

A reference to an out of date section of the Companies Act 1985 is also being updated.
